


Port of Adria Overview

Port of Adria has an operational quay of 1.440 meters long.

There is a possibility to berth various types of ships on all nine berths at the same time as per international practices.

Container Terminal and Services

Terminal is equipped for unloading, handling and loading containers, stuffing and stripping of containers. All the activities are carried out both on open storages and in warehouses, depending on the goods and required handling methods.

Key features:

- Operational quay length of 1,5 km
- 2 STSG container cranes
- Maximum permissible draft 11,5 m
- 270 Reefer plugs
- Railway tracks reach every berth and warehouse





Container Freight Station

(ADDITIONAL SERVICES)

- Stuffing/Stripping of containers
- Lashing/Unlashing of containers
- Cleaning, washing containers with water and/or chemicals
- Reefer containers services such as PTI, monitoring
- Reefer containers plugs comply with ISO standards
- Container repairs

- Video surveillance system installed on the Container Terminal provides maximum security and safety of containers
